Narrative Reports: Narrative reports are a chance to tell your unit's story. Share what was done in Your own words.

Impact Reports: A report of the number of hours and dollars spent on Auxiliary programs, and number Of Veterans/Families served.

As part of your Narrative Report, please include answers to the following questions.

1. Did member/Unit participate in Teacher Appreciation Week? How?
2. How was Give 10 participation recognized in your Unit.
3. Describe how Veterans in Community Schools programs were presented?
4. If units actively support veterans associations on campus, describe their activities?
5. What types of help did Unit give a needy student?
6. How did Units recognize scholarship winners?
7. How many scholarship application were received for National Scholarships.
