

## Auxiliary Emergency Fund

Auxiliary Emergency Fund (AEF) is here to help auxiliary member in need. Eligibility: Person/s who have been members for ALA for at least past two years consecutively and whose currently membership dues are paid at time emergency occurs (3 consecutively years due) may apply for assistance. The maximum grant amount is \$2400.

You are perhaps wondering AEF fund got started. In 1969 Helen Colby Small Burlington, WI, bequest from her estate. She was an auxiliary member. Continue today solely through generous donations by Auxiliary members.

Donations of \$50 or more will receive pin. AEF donations will go to the state office and pins will be sent to those that have made the donation. Units that give \$500 or more will receive pins for everyone in their unit. Give what you can afford.
