Veterans Day at Napoleon Public School 11-8-2018

Patriotic Heroes Recognized at NPS

"Patriotic Heroes – Thank-a-Veteran" program was held at the Napoleon Public School on Thursday, November 8th with the Napoleon American Legion Post 72 and Auxiliary Unit participating in the program.

The program opened with the presentation of colors by the American Legion Color Guard of Napoleon, followed by the pledge to flag, and the singing of the national anthem led by Olivia Svanes, Sophie Ketterling, Emma Ketterling and Clarissa Buechler. Mr. Bales, the music instructor, assisted with the presentation of patriotic songs by grades K-6 throughout the program.

The guest speaker, Cole Johnson, shared a message of pride for his service in the North Dakota National Guard and the remembrance in 2018 of soldiers who served in World War I. Cole shared "for me eight years ago that wasn't something I had considered. Defending your country, that sounds honorable and heroic, but for me it was a job, it was just something to do. I joined the guard because I have a father, some uncles, some cousins and countless other friends who joined some sort of the military branch." He was deployed to Afghanistan with a company of about 100 with the mission to locate, dismantle or detonate roadside bombs. While in Afghanistan he learned the meaning of brotherhood, an important life lesson regardless of religion, political views, social status or being male or female. Cole said "Everyone has their own struggles in life, don't forget that...I saw it in war zones and I see it here at home... Veterans Day is about celebrating our Veterans...Thank the ones that served before me, and thank the ones that served to the right and left of me. Next time you see a man or woman wearing a hat, or someone that has insignia that represents they have served, shake their hand and thank them."

Kassie Breidenbach, student council president, announced and recognized special guest veterans from Napoleon Care Center, John Gross and Leo Ibach, both served in the US Army; Napoleon American Legion and Community Veterans attending the program.

Auxiliary President Viola Wolf and Peggy Welder, Auxiliary Vice President presented the winner of the largest flag pole contest to Eli Ketterling, 6th grade with the correct answer "Sheboygan, Wisconsin". Ann Knecht announced two special awards presented this year. A "Create Your Own Stamp" award won by Amelia Moch, grade 5. Her entry will be used for the 2019 Veterans Day event and contests. The "Patriotic Hero" award won by Michael Moch, grade 3, portrayed a saluting soldier using stamp art.

American Legion Post 72 of Napoleon members participating in the color guard were Ron Kerzman and Dennis Hottman.

"TAPS" was presented by Sophie Ketterling, band member before the audience left the gym in silence.

Cheryl Weigel, Napoleon Post Master displayed some of the stamp art in the Post Office. Andrea Leier, school librarian assisted by hosting an Art Contest display in the school library. Judges for this year's event were Cheryl Weigel, Alvina Hamel, Viola Wolf, Peggy Welder and Ann Knecht.

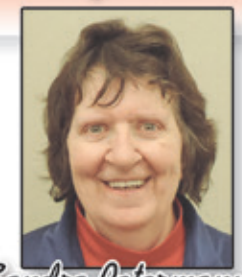

The first two years as District President have gone by so fast and it's been an amazing experience. Thank you everyone, for your support. I look forward to working with you in the coming two years.

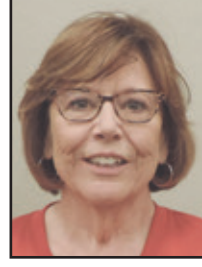

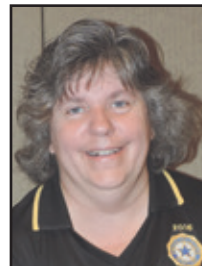
Gift Shop-VA&R Program
