CLC Aquarium Project

The Community Living Center aquarium is a source of comfort and entertainment for residents staying at the Fargo VA.

The tank maintenance and fish replacement costs are entirely paid for by donations.

The annual cost to maintain the program is \$1.800.

Emergent Needs Fund

Emergent (Unexpcted and Emergency) Needs and Emergent Needs Travel funds are used to assist Veterans overcome an unanticipated hardship.

Examples of use include unexpected medical travel, food shortage, etc.

Military Sexual Trauma (MST) Program

Military Sexual Trauma (MST) refers to sexual assault or harrassment experienced during military service.

VA uses donated funds to support the program by covering booth rental/space at outreach events, providing therapeutic literature to Veterans that supplements treatment, and purchasing outreach/awareness items.

Emergency Food Bags

Food scarcity is a major issue among homeless/at-risk Veterans. Organizations bring their teams together to shop, build, and ultimately deliver emergency food bags for Veterans to ensure that they have at least three days of nutritional food.
