- Study the 'Bills of Rights' which the Constitution guarantees every citizen

"To maintain law and order..."

- Recognize law enforcement office of the year
- Prepare a dinner or coffee and donuts breakfast for officers in your community
- Join with law enforcement officers in promoting a neighborhood watch program

"To foster and perpetuate a one hundred percent Americanism..."

- Sponsor the Americanism Essay Contest in your community's schools
- Teach school children flag etiquette
- Present Certificates of Appreciation to business owners who display the American flag
- Perform a proper flag disposal ceremony for the community using flags from area businesses that are no longer serviceable.

"To preserve the memories and incidents of our association during all wars..."

- Invite citizens in your community to Veterans Day and Memorial Day ceremonies conducted by your unit
- Sponsor a program and invite veterans to speak to students at your community's school
- Visit military veterans who served our country during any conflict

"To inculcate a sense of individual obligation to the community, state and nation..."

- Become reading volunteers in your local schools
- Become volunteers in the VA Medical Center and nursing homes
- Participate in community gatherings and activities.

- Sponsor a program on the American Disabilities Act or similar group to inform members of everyone's rights
