Constant Contact is the new mass email platform utilized by the Department Office. We will be using this email more and more to get information out to members in a timely manner. We currently have approximately 300 email addresses. Our old system had about 1800 addresses. Units, we need your help in obtaining the email addresses of members that would like to receive Department information. We would appreciate any assistance from units and members to get this information platform up and running effectively. The newsletters can be shared in our monthly mailings as well as through Constant Contact.
