PATTERN # 7-2021

Heart Pillow

Facilities using this Pattern are:

Fargo and Minneapolis VAHCS

(as always contact facility to be sure they are in need before spending your \$\$ and time)

Needed:


3/4 yard of Fabric plus ¾ yard of contrasting (Total 1 ½ yards of fabric)
Polyester Fiberfill
Thread Needle to hand stitch closing
Sewing machine
¼-inch seam allowance for seams unless noted

- Finished size is approximately 18x18 inches
- 1. Attach pattern pieces together. Arrows do not match up. (see photo below)
- 2. Cut 1 from fabric plus Cut 1 from contrasting fabric (Cut 2 total)
- 3. With right sides together stitch together leaving approximately a 3-4-inch opening on one side.

4.	To Reduce bulk clip the top edge
	curves – do not clip into stitching.

- 5. Turn right side out and press.
- 6. Stuff with polyester fiberfill
- 7. be sure, to make very firm
- 8. Hand stitch closed.

NOTE: A 50 oz bag of polyfil will fill 3(+/-) pillows.




Heart Pillow Pattern Piece Actual size
