Four units sent in nominations for 'Unit Member of the Year' award consideration. Although every nominee deserves to be awarded this honor, the committee and I selected Ruth Quam, a life member of Hafner-Miller-Ross Unit 20 of Wahpeton as North Dakota's Unit Member of the Year.
