## Encourage participation in scholarships

Encourage local youth and Junior American Legion Auxiliary members to apply for scholarships from the local American Legion Auxiliary unit by:

- Working with your unit to create a scholarship.
- Ask schools to allow you to do a bulletin board about scholarship opportunities within The American Legion Family.
- Publish information in your local newspaper, libraries, and on your unit's social media.
- Host a "Scholarship Night" Zoom meeting to inform students and parents about Legion Family scholarship opportunities.
- Start a partnership with a local college to provide their students with scholarship information.
- Ask the local Board of Education to host a "Scholarship Workshop" in their schools.
  - o Work with the schools to invite college administrators to speak.
  - o Have volunteers assist students with scholarship applications.

## Raise awareness about Veterans in Schools

Many children do not know a veteran and therefore do not have an appreciation for the sacrifices made by our military heroes.

- Work with your American Legion post to participate in Veterans in Community Schools.
- Ask teachers to have their students make cards for veterans.
- Partner with your local schools to invite veterans into schools.
- Work with teachers to prepare students to ask appropriate questions from the veteran, as well as inappropriate questions to not ask.

## Plan a Veterans Day program at school where veterans can:

- Be the color guard for the beginning of the program.
- Introduce their military branch of the service to students.
- Mingle with children and share snacks.
