

Gift Cards

- **\$25/\$50 Walmart Gift Cards:** to be provided to Veterans to cover a wide variety of emergent needs
- **\$25/\$50 Grocery Store Gift Cards:** to be provided to Veterans in need (Hornbacher's, Cashwise, Family Fare, etc.)
- **\$25/\$50 Dollar General/Family Dollar gift cards:** to be provided to rural Veterans in need

Clothing Items for Emergent Needs or Homeless Veterans:

All items must be brand new with tags or in original packaging per facility policy

- Sweatpants, Small—5XL
- Hooded zip-up sweatshirts, Small-5XL
- T-shirts, Small—5XL
- Men's underwear, Small— 2XL

NOTE: socks are NOT needed at this time

Sewn Items

- 60" x 80" blankets or comforters in masculine colors/prints

NOTE: Lap robes and Afghans are NOT needed at this time

- *Walker bags
- *Wheelchair bags
- *Wound-vac bags
- Port-access shirts

*Emergency Food Bags for Homeless and At-Risk Veterans

*These food bags have been designed to meet the needs of this unique Veteran population as they do not require cooking, microwaving, refrigeration, or a can opener. Please ONLY include the items listed below. The Homeless Program cannot accept anything outside of this list.

Each paper or reusable grocery bag should contain:

- 3 Hormel "Compleats" (easy-open and shelf-stable meals)
- 3 individual servings of beef jerky
- 3 individual packets of trail mix
- 3 containers of Easy Mac
- 3 protein shakes
- 3 bottles of water
- 3 granola bars
- 3 fruit cups
- 3 Individual servings of tuna or peanut butter and crackers
