8801	General Purpose	Flexibility to use donations as best needed for Veterans. Most effective way to ensure Veterans can get the help they need when they need it
8803	Palliative Care	Support Palliative Care/Hospice Veterans and families with refreshments, canteen books, outreach items, memorial service, etc.
8804	Emergent Needs	Supports indigent patients with a variety of emergent needs
8804	Emergent Needs Travel	Supports eligible Veterans experiencing difficulty getting to and from VA appointments or home after a hospital discharge
8805	Premium Movie Channels	Provides hospitalized Veterans with movie channels (western channel)
8806	Recreation and Outings	Patient activities, outings, entertainment, food, prizes, decorations, etc.
8806	Holiday Meals	Please contact the CDCE before donating to this account
8806	Pet Therapy/Fish Tank	Fish tank, bird feeders and other items for the Pet Therapy program
8806	Healthy Teaching Kitchen	Hands on class to teach Veterans to cook simple, health meals on a budget

8807	National Salute	Used to honor Veterans during the week of National Salute to Veterans
8807	Toiletries/Comfort Items	Comfort items, toiletries, backscratchers, neck pillows, chap stick, etc.
8807	Creative Arts/Art Therapy	Creative Arts Festival and creative arts therapy supplies
8810	Faith	Supports the religious needs of the health care system
8811	Holiday Fund	Holiday events and fun for Veterans
8812	Volunteer Recognition	Provides much deserved recognition events and gifts for volunteers
8814	Women Veterans	Used for Women Veterans in any way that is beneficial to them
8814	Veteran Baby Shower	Supplies and gifts for the annual Veteran Baby Shower event
*8814	MST Outreach	Military Sexual Trauma outreach supplies, education, books, etc.
*8814	Women's Whole Health Retreat	Supports Whole Health Retreats for Women Veterans to facilitate a day of Whole Health mind-body approaches to nurture the body and soul and promote healing
8816	CBOCs	Assist Veterans at any of our outpatient community clinics
8817	Vet Centers	Assist Veterans at any of our Vet Centers

Sewn Items

- 60" x 80" blankets or comforters in masculine colors/prints

*Emergency Food Bags for Homeless and At-Risk Veterans

*These food bags have been designed to meet the needs of this unique Veteran population as they do not require cooking, microwaving, refrigeration, or a can opener. Please ONLY include the items listed below. The Homeless Program cannot accept anything outside of this list.

Each paper or reusable grocery bag should contain:

- 3 Hormel "Compleats" (easy-open and shelf-stable meals)
- 3 individual servings of beef jerky
- 3 individual packets of trail mix
- 3 containers of Easy Mac
- 3 protein shakes
- 3 bottles of water
- 3 granola bars
- 3 fruit cups
- 3 Individual servings of tuna or peanut butter and crackers
